



Ontario Parks Reservation Planning Template

To help make your reservation process as smooth and as accurate as possible, please complete this chart prior to calling the park.

- Decide whether you would like a Park Naturalist to run a program for you, or whether your visit will be self-guided.
- If you would like the services of a Park Naturalist, decide which program (s) you would like. Be prepared with alternatives, as all programs are not offered at all times. Note that programs are free at most parks, but Algonquin Park charges a fee.
- Decide whether this will be a day visit, or whether you will stay overnight.
- If you're going to stay overnight, decide whether you would like to camp, or if you would prefer roofed accommodations (a yurt, cabin or cottage). You can find out which parks have these facilities available by going to www.OntarioParks.com, or looking in the Parks Guide. Algonquin Park also offers overnight stays at its Visitor Centre.
- Figure when you would like to visit. Be prepared with alternatives, as you may not always get your preferred date(s).
- Note all relevant costs -- entrance fee and possibly a program fee (Algonquin only).
- Note that some parks have limits on the number of students per program. You may have to book more than one time slot, and rotate them through.
- Call the park directly to book your reservation. Phone numbers are listed at www.OntarioParks.com, in the Parks Guide, or on the List of Ontario Parks School Programs in the Park Visits portion of the virtual Visitor Centre at www.Campsite24.ca.
